Flea Market Rules

- WHEN ARRIVING, VENDORS MUST USE THE FLEA MARKET ENTRANCE GATE.
- Check-in is Monday, Tuesday, and Wednesday before the show, from 9:00 am 5:00 pm. and Thursday from 6:00 am 9:00 am.
- The show starts promptly on Thursday morning at 9:00 am.
- If you have not called, and/or do not arrive on time, your lots are subject to open up to waiting vendors.
- Each lot purchased includes 2 show bands. Each additional person pays \$10.00 per day or \$25.00 for the entire show, no exceptions.
- NO REFUNDS There is no refund for your lot/s if you are not able to make it.
- If you arrive after hours you will have to park in the vendor parking lot across the street.
- Only after your contract is signed and money has been paid, will your lot/s be reserved.
- Lots are distributed to new vendors on a first come first serve basis. You will be given your lot assignment number when you check-in at the show. Any requests for a specific lot/s must be written on the contract and then will be fulfilled as available.
- Everything must fit within your lot boundaries.
- No setup on lots after 8:00 pm.
- Your vehicle can be parked behind your display if it fits on the lot. It cannot be moved during the show hours of 9:00 am 7:00 pm.
- There is NO PARKING on empty lots.
- No driving in the flea market during the show hours of 9:00 am 7:00 pm.
- We DO NOT provide electric hookup for flea market vendors. Power is for the food vendors only.
- All pets must be kept on a leash and on your lot. Pets are not allowed in the show area.
- Generator curfew is 10:00 pm 7:00 am.
- If camping on your lot; your merchandise/display <u>MUST</u> be set up in front of your camp setup. You may not purchase a lot in the flea market for camping. We have a vendor camping area available for \$20.00 per day.
- There is no selling outside your booth; no roving vendors allowed.
- There are no campfires allowed within the flea market area.
- Lots must be left in the same condition as when you arrived. You may be assessed for any damage or trash.
- Trash will be picked up several times a day at the end of each aisle. Please have boxes broken down and garbage disposed of properly. 25# or less per bag.
- If you choose to have packages shipped to the showgrounds, you must sign and pay the C.O.D. for your own packages. Workers will not be held responsible for any deliveries made to the showgrounds.
- There is to be NO food or drinks sold by anyone not approved as a registered Food Vendor.
- All vendors must have all their property removed from the showgrounds/flea market area by the Tuesday morning following the last day of the show.
